## STATUTORY NOTIFICATION

### Waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) proposed for junction of Commerce Road and Finsbury Road N22.

Dear Resident or Trader,

To address obstructive parking issues identified at the junction of Commerce Road and Finsbury Road N22, we propose to introduce double yellow lines and reposition the 'School Keep Clear' markings, as indicated on the attached plan. The restrictions will ensure these areas are kept free of obstructive parking for the benefit of all road users.

Formal notice of our proposals will be published in the London Gazette, local press and on site. This notification letter marks the start of a three week period during which we welcome all views, comments and suggestions in support of, or objecting to, the proposals. Please give reasons for your views, as this adds useful context and background detail.

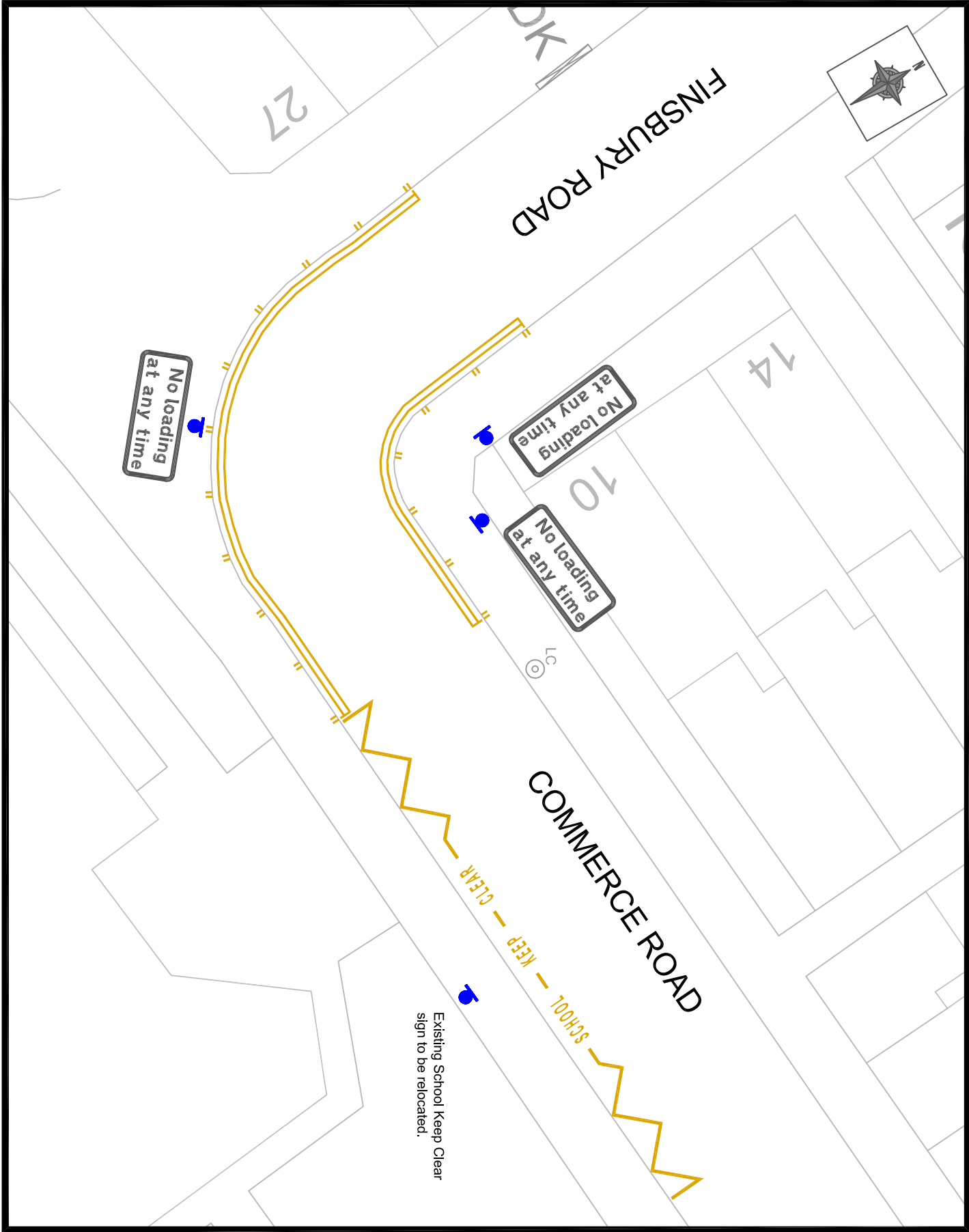
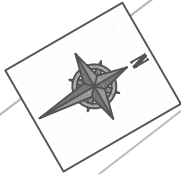
