Shared Zebra Crossing on Priory Road N8

Dear Resident,

Following our recent consultation exercise on pedestrian and cycle improvements on Priory Road, I would like to thank all who contacted us with their views and comments. The feedback was very helpful.

The Council received a high response rate to the consultation exercise, and clearly there is significant local community interest in this project. I can now inform you that the Council has decided to proceed with the implementation of the pedestrian/cycle improvements on Priory Road, with some small changes to the design resulting from your feedback. These include a slight repositioning of the proposed shared zebra crossing, introduction of half a box junction and omitting the build-outs on Park Avenue South, please see plan overleaf for full details.

The work is programmed to be carried out week commencing 03 October 2011 and is likely to take 6 weeks to complete. During this period there may be some disturbance to residents and traffic movements to facilitate the safe implementation of site works. We would like to apologise in advance for any inconvenience caused.
