Statutory Notification

Rangemoor Road Junction Improvements

Dear Resident or Trader,

I am pleased to inform you that the Council has secured funding to construct a raised speed table at the junction of Rangemoor Road and Herbert Road; and a raised flower-bed at the junction of Rangemoor Road and Norman Road N15.

The proposed raised table is designed to reduce vehicle speeds on the approach to this junction and to increase safety for all road users in the immediate vicinity.

In order to 'allow room' for the raised table at the junction, the existing single yellow line will be extended by 3 metres, which will in turn shorten the length of the group of parking bays by 3 metres. Full details are set out on the plan overleaf.

This notification marks the start of a three week period during which we welcome any views, comments or 'representations' you may have. You can 'have your say' by completing the enclosed Freepost comment card, or by email to frontline.consultation@haringey.gov.uk or you can telephone the Senior Engineer Nadia Kamali on 020 8489 1695.

Please ensure that we receive your views no later than 4 November 2011, so that we can consider any comments before taking a decision. Depending on the nature of any objections, the works are likely to start on 14 November and are expected to take four weeks to complete, weather permitting. Although we expect and intend the road to be open to traffic at all times; there may be occasional delays resulting from heavy road machinery movements.

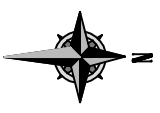
We will make every effort to minimise disruption while the work is in progress but I would like to take this opportunity to apologise in advance for any inconvenience that might be caused.
