OUTCOME OF STATUTORY NOTIFICATION – WORKS NOTICE

EXPANSION OF HARINGEY CAR CLUB SCHEME

Dear Resident,

You may recall receiving our statutory notification inviting comments on proposals to introduce 20 new additional car club bays in various locations across the borough.

We are grateful to the 88 residents who made comments and representations and are encouraged by the strong support shown by so many residents towards car club expansion. Full details of all comments and representations can be found in a report now available on the council's website at: www.haringey.gov.uk > Environment and Transport > Parking > Parking Consultations.

Having considered all representations as part of the decision-making process on car club expansion, the council has approved the proposed 20 new car club bays at the locations listed below. There will be one new bay at each of these locations:

Bedford Road N15	Lineley Road N17
Briston Grove N8	Marden Road N17
Clyde Road N22	Northwood Road N6
Coniston Road N10	Roslyn Road N15
Crawley Road N22	Russell Road N8
Denmark Street N17	Wargrave Avenue N15
Harefield Road N8	Wolves Lane N22
Haslemere Road N8	Woodland Rise N10
Hermiston Avenue N8	

Granville Road N4 will have two new bays.

Detailed location plans of all bays are available on the Council's website.

When will the bays be ready?

The council will start implementation works on the 21 March 2011 and expects this to be completed for all locations by 15 April 2011. We will make every effort to keep any disruption to a minimum. Delivery of the car club vehicles will start when the bays are ready. Residents should be aware that only car club vehicles may occupy these bays. Unauthorised vehicles will receive a Penalty Charge Notice and be subject to removal.

Joining the car club

Car club vehicles in Haringey are operated by Streetcar. Before using these vehicles you will need to purchase Streetcar membership which costs £59.50 for one year. To celebrate the expansion of the car club scheme, Streetcar is offering Haringey residents £30 free driving credit if they join the scheme before the end of June. To take advantage of this offer please quote '**HGY30**' when you apply to join. Full information is available online at www.streetcar.com or you can telephone Streetcar on 0845 644 8475.

The simple steps to join the car club and book a vehicle are:

- Register with streetcar to receive a smartcard and PIN number.
- Book your car out for any duration from an hour upwards.
- Swipe your smartcard to gain access to your car and enter the PIN number.
- Return the car to its dedicated parking bay when you are finished.

Not only is it easy to use but Streetcar offers a choice of vehicles to members ranging from VW Golf, Polo, BMW Series One, to VW Touran People Carriers and Transporter vans. Vehicles can be hired for just an hour or for longer periods of up to 6 months.

Haringey's car club scheme offers Streetcar members access to 87 cars and vans, along with 9 off-road vehicles. The expanded service means there are now car club bays at many more convenient locations across the borough.

Future developments

As car club membership and demand continue to grow, the Council plans further expansion with the intention that every resident and business will be within a 5 minute walk of a car club vehicle.

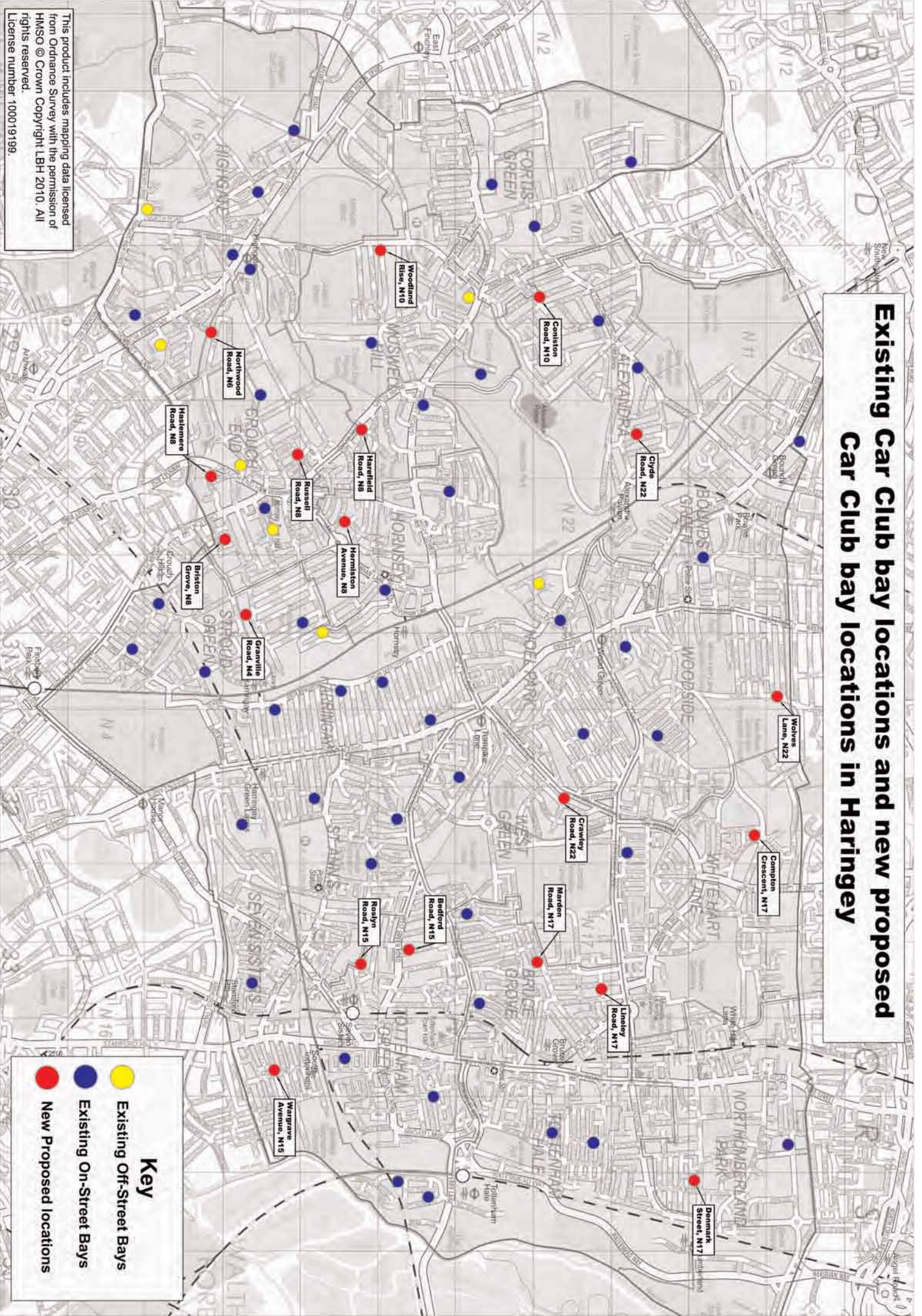

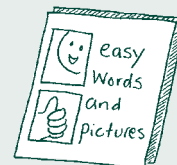
