

## Points of Interest

Bruce Castle Museum lies to the west of the park. It houses an interesting collection of the borough's local history and archives. For centuries the area surrounding the manor house was mainly woodland and countryside, often used for hunting. By 1892, many of the trees had been sold for timber. One ancient tree, a large 400 year old oak located close to the centre of the park, stands as a well-known landmark. A tree trail around the park identifies different species and points out other trees thought to be over 200 years old. Details are available from the museum.

Bruce Castle Park plays host to a variety of activities including the Tottenham Community Festival and Carnival, a multi-cultural event for all the family, every June.

## Green Flag Winner

Bruce Castle won the Green Flag Award in both 2003 and 2004. This is given by the Civic Trust in association with CABE Space, in recognition of achieving and maintaining excellent standards for a public park.

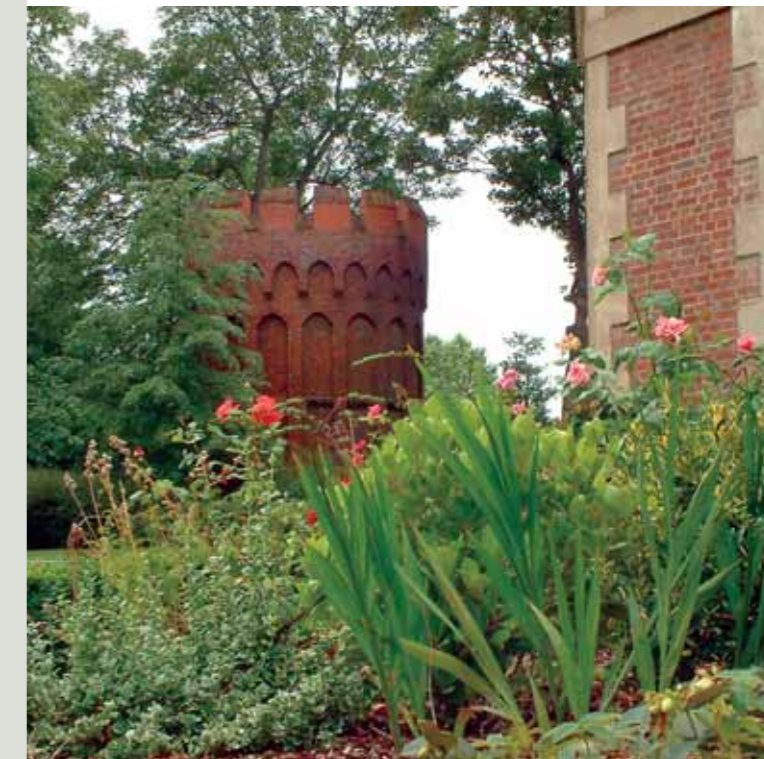

## Introducing: Bruce Castle Park

Bruce Castle Park covers eight hectares of parkland in the heart of Tottenham and dates back to the early 11th Century. The grounds and its surviving manor house were purchased for the public by Tottenham Urban District Council in 1892 and are now owned by Haringey Council.



Over the past century Bruce Castle Park and Museum have become vibrant and valued local resources for schools, the community and visitors to Tottenham.
