What does this mean for us?	<p>The formulation of a Service Plan is a statutory requirement, which will also be examined during Food Standard Agency Audits.</p> <p>Each year a revised business plan will be developed following review of the previous year's performance against the plan. This process is led by the Team Leader with input from the Food Safety Team.</p>
