Bruce Castle is a Grade I listed 16th Century manor house in 20 acres of parkland. Exhibitions cover the history of the local area and Bruce Castle itself, and include many examples of local paintings, photographs and prints. There is an exciting new interactive exhibition devoted to local inventors and we host regular temporary local history and art exhibitions. Visiting groups are welcome. The Museum offers free workshops for schools and community groups and lots of activities for families at weekends and during school.

Refreshments are available. There is seating inside and outside the museum. Groups may bring packed lunches by appointment. The Museum is free to all visitors.
