## Identification (ID)

One ID item to show your name and address and the other to show your name and signature.

Refugees and asylum seekers: if you can show us a letter from the Home Office with your name and address on it, that will be enough.

Examples of what we will accept:

- medical card
- letter from your doctor
- letter from hospital
- passport or ID card
- driving licence
- electricity bill
- gas bill
- water bill
- letter from a utility company
- bank statement
- credit or bank card
- letter from your bank
- rent book
- tenancy agreement
- letter from your landlord
- mortgage contract
- letter from mortgage lender
- social security order
- letter from DSS
- other official letters

*All ID must be valid and current or dated within three months.*
