Community Alarm Service

Are you elderly, long-term sick, disabled or living alone? If so, you can apply for a Safe & Sound alarm which gives you help and support in an emergency at the touch of a button.

Our Control Centre is staffed 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, by experienced, friendly operators, supported by a team of Area

Relief Officers who can deal swiftly with any emergency.

The cost of this service is subsidised by Haringey Council and can be further reduced if you are entitled to Housing Benefit.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Customers must be person/s living alone or frequently left alone. They must also satisfy one of these circumstances.

- Housebound or have a need to contact medical services urgently.
- Unable to leave the house unaided.
- Victim of crime or harassment.
- Situation and/or condition of applicant's dwelling makes them significantly vulnerable to accident or attack.

N.B. All customers need to be physically and mentally able to use the alarm to summon help in an emergency.
