Since the riots this summer, a huge amount of effort has gone into trying to get Tottenham back on its feet as swiftly as possible.

I hope that many of you will have noticed the work that has been done, and you may even have benefited from the support we've given to residents and traders who were directly affected by the disturbances.

The council has offered advice and support with housing, helped businesses to make insurance claims and access grants and business rate relief, and has launched the **I ♥ Tottenham** campaign to help restore pride and confidence in the High Road.

I've been consistently impressed by the strength of courage shown by local

residents and traders, and I know that the community has rallied round and shown great loyalty to local businesses who need support now more than ever.
