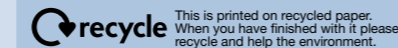

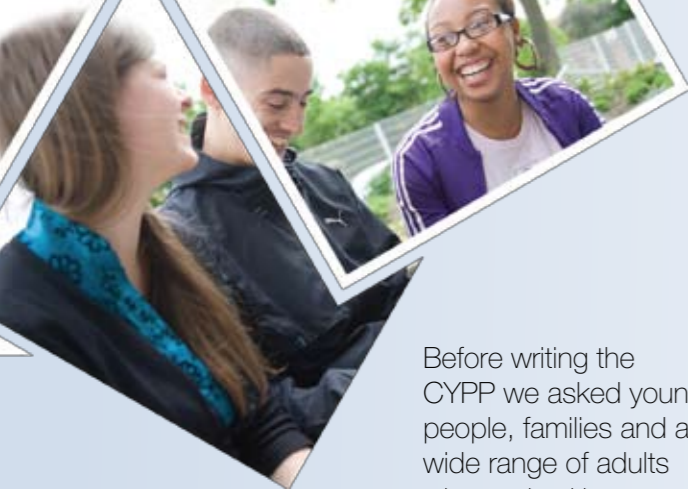
Children and Young People's Plan 2009-2020

The Children and Young People's Plan (CYPP)

If you are one of around 55,000 children and young people living in Haringey or the parent / carer of one, the CYPP is for you.

It sets out important priorities to ensure that children and young people can make the most of opportunities, fulfill ambitions and future life plans.

The Government requires all local authorities to have a CYPP. Ours sets out what we want to achieve by 2020.

Before writing the CYPP we asked young people, families and a wide range of adults who work with young people, what we should include. We also carried out a needs assessment and completed an evaluation of our first plan Changing Lives 2006-09. This helped us to better understand what still needs to be done.

We will look at the Plan each year, based on your feedback, and review our priorities accordingly.

The CYPP is the main plan for all children and young people in Haringey. Other strategies and plans feed into it. That is why it is very important.

Haringey's Children's Trust Vision

We want every child and young person to be happy, healthy, safe and confident about the future.

Haringey's Children's Trust is a group of adults who work for all children and young people in the borough, including health services, police, council, schools, colleges and voluntary and community groups. Together they have set a vision for the work they do for you.

Our Values

The Children's Trust has agreed five values which will shape the way services are delivered for you.



The following values are aimed directly at children and young people:

1. We will work to ensure that you are protected and safeguarded.
2. You will be valued, treated as an individual and be involved in decisions that affect you.
3. We will work, whenever possible, with your parents/ carers and local community to make sure they are able to support and guide you, and set high expectations for what you can achieve.
4. You will get the help and advice you need to make the most of the opportunities and choices available.
5. We will support you to achieve and take pride in your community and celebrate the many achievements of our young people.

The Children's Trust has identified five themes in the CYPP.

They are:

- keep vulnerable children safe and look after their welfare
- step in early to prevent bad things getting worse
- address child poverty and tackle the inequalities that exist between groups of young people
- support your social and mental well-being
- ensure all our services work together to help you.

The CYPP is divided into five outcomes

Each outcome has two priorities to be achieved by 2020.

Each priority is broken down into tasks to be achieved by the end of 2012.

The outcomes below are aimed directly at children and young people

Be healthy

Priority 1

Improve health and well-being.

We will help you to:

- be healthy, learn how to stay healthy and tell you where to get information and help if you need it.
- cope with the ups and downs of life and, if you are worried, make sure you have someone to talk to.

Priority 2

Improve the sexual health of young people.

We will:

- help you to understand social relationships, and how to avoid sexually transmitted infections.
- work with you to reduce high levels of teenage conception and pregnancy.

Stay safe

Priority 3

Improve child protection.

We will:

- ensure everyone is working together to protect you from harm.
- promote good practice and improve our safeguarding and child protection services.

Priority 4

Develop positive human relationships and ensure personal safety.

We will:

- help you to build positive relationships but also allow you the opportunity to take part in safe and exciting activities.
- continue to improve how we work together so that we can give better services in your local area.

Enjoy and achieve

Priority 5

Develop schooling and services with high expectations of young people:

- we want you to do well in your exams.
- we expect you to do your best and will support you to progress with your learning.

Priority 6

Develop lifelong learning in a range of subjects both in and out of school:

- we want you to enjoy learning and develop your hobbies and interests.

Make a positive contribution

Priority 7

Have a greater stake in the future and take pride in the local community.

We will:

- promote your ideas. You can give us feedback, so that our services reflect your views.
- celebrate your achievements and help you to take part in community activities.

Priority 8

Develop global citizens.

We will:

- promote your rights and build your knowledge and understanding of others, including different cultures, ethics, beliefs, faiths and civic responsibilities.
- help you to better understand the world, the environment and current issues, through international exchange programmes.
