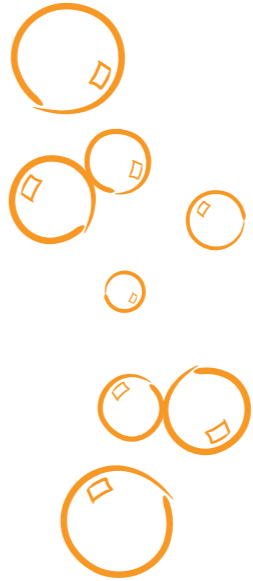

Childcare information

We offer full and part time **nursery places** for children aged three to eleven years in a range of settings. Children enjoy a range of activities to support their learning, growth and development. Also, you can get information from us about local childminders.

Times of sessions during term time

Nursery (Rainbow – fee paying)
2-3 years, full time and part time
8am – 5.45pm, 47 weeks a year

School Nursery (term time only – no charge)
3-4 years, full time only
8.55am – 3.15pm

Breakfast Club (Treetops – fee paying*)
3-11 years, 8am – 8.55am

After School Club (Treetops – fee paying*)
3-5 years, 3.15pm – 5:45pm

After School Club (Hideaway – fee paying*)
5-11 years, 3.15pm – 6pm

*Concession fees are available
