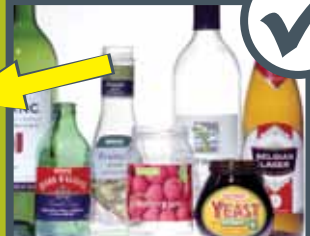


What can I recycle?

Yes please



PAPER, CARDBOARD & CARTONS
Please flatten all cardboard



GLASS BOTTLES & JARS
Please rinse and remove lids



TINS & CANS
Please rinse

Please place all the recycling together in the same bin.

All recycling is collected together and sorted out later for re-processing.



PLASTIC POTS, TUBS TRAYS & BOTTLES
Please rinse and remove lids.

All items should be clean and free of food

No thanks



No plastic wrapping or films



No polystyrene or crisp packets



No textiles, clothes or shoes.

How to use the service?



The recycling bins may be locked, so please lift the flap on the lid to put items into the bins.

Please do not use the recycling bins at night so that you do not disturb your neighbours.

Please only put the ✓ items in your recycling bins. Other rubbish, including the ✗ items, should be put into existing refuse bins. Do not leave any other rubbish or bulky items next to or on top of the recycling bins.
