

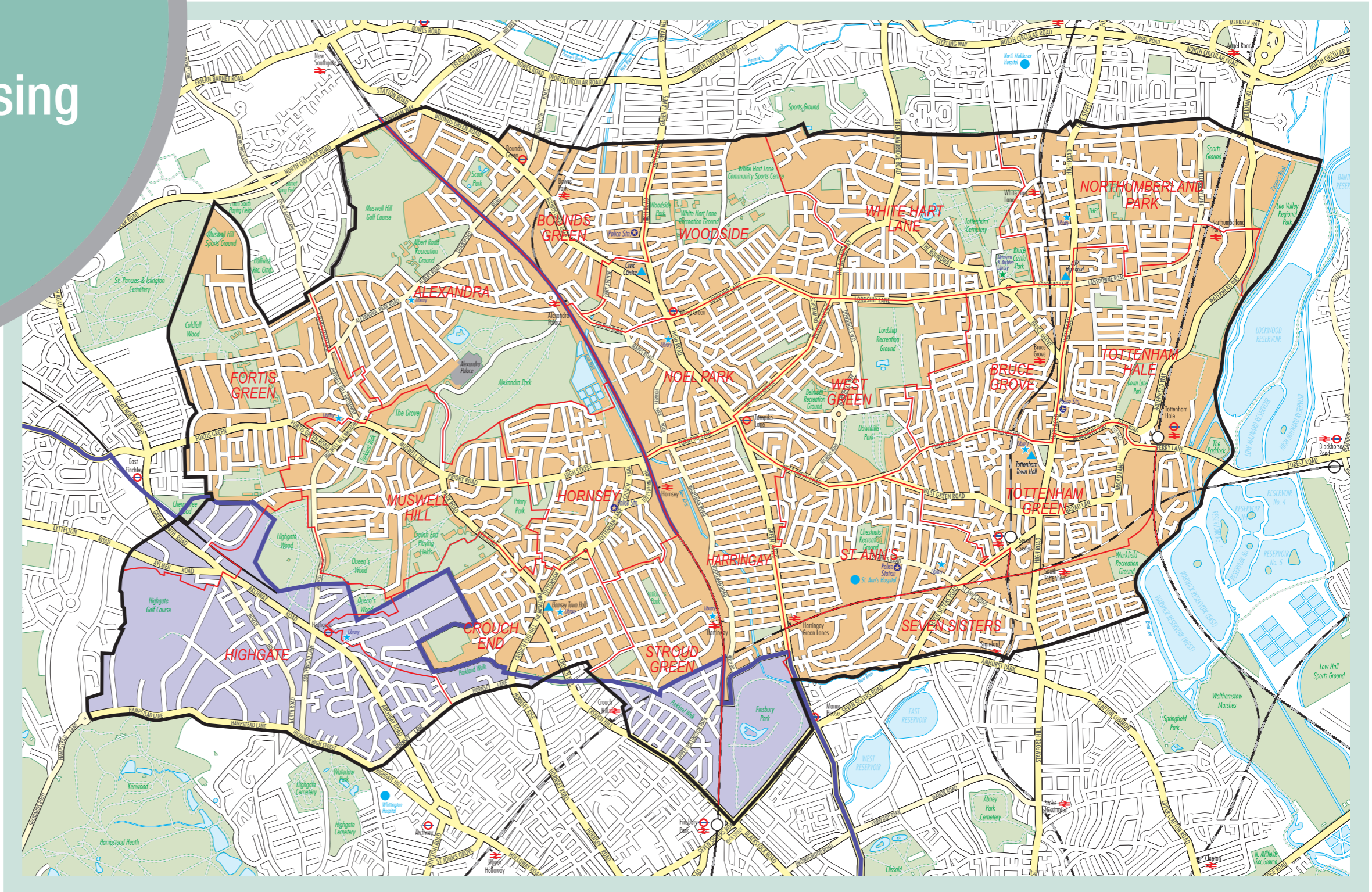
How to work out which Local Housing Allowance rate applies to you:

Step 1

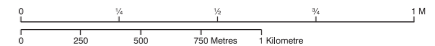
Look at the map and work out which Broad Rental Market Area you live in.

If you live in the area shaded purple, you live in the 'Inner North and West London' BRMA. If you live in the other area shaded orange, you live in the 'Outer North London' BRMA.

Step 2

Work out how many bedrooms you are entitled to. You will be entitled to one bedroom for:

- ❖ every adult couple (married or unmarried)

- ❖ every other adult aged 16 or over
- ❖ any two children of the same sex under the age of 16
- ❖ any two children regardless of sex under the age of 10
- ❖ any other child

Step 3

Once you have your BRMA and you know the number of bedrooms you are entitled to, check the relevant box below for your Local Housing Allowance rate.
