Turnpike Lane/West Green Area DIY Streets Project

Dear Resident or Trader,

As a result of our recent statutory notification exercise in your area we have changed the proposed speed reduction feature in your street. The amendment has been as a result of resident concerns regarding the initial design and loss of parking. A report setting out the statutory notification feedback is now available on the council's website (www.haringey.gov.uk) under Environment & Transport > Roads & Streets > Road Safety > Road Safety Consultations.

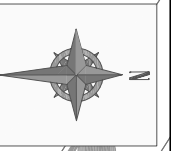
We now propose an alternative feature on Mannock Road which is a block work speed table that aims to substantially reduce vehicle speeds while not resulting in a loss of on street parking, see plan overleaf. As part of this proposal new drainage would be provided to ensure ponding does not occur as a result of this feature.

This notification leaflet marks the start of a statutory notification 21 day period in which we invite you to tell us what you think about the proposals set out in the plan overleaf.
