

## Feedback from Statutory Notification Extension of Highgate Controlled Parking Zone to include Hampstead Lane

Purpose of consultation:	<p>To inform of the council's intention to extend the Highgate Controlled Parking Zone to include Hampstead Lane from its junction with North Road to the Eastern arm of Bishopswood Road.</p> <p>Statutory notification is part of a legal process we must carry out before introducing certain measures on the public highway. This process provides a 21-day consultation period for interested parties to submit representation to our intentions. During this period it is common that most representations will be objections. The objections are analysed according to the comments made, rather than based on "Yes/No" response rate.</p> <p>It was proposed that parking bays and waiting restrictions be introduced.</p> <p>The scheme was proposed in order to relieve parking congestion along Hampstead Lane.</p>
Methodology:	<p><b>Consultation under the Statutory Process</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 100 Statutory notification letters were distributed to Hampstead Lane.</li> <li>• Notices were placed in the London Gazette, local press, lamp columns and on the council website</li> <li>• The public had the opportunity to view the plans and discuss the proposals in person by making an appointment with council officers.</li> </ul>
Findings:	<p><b>Statutory Process findings</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We received a total of 38 representations under the statutory process.</li> </ul> <p>From the objections received the following issues were raised:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The scheme was supported by the majority of respondents, 31, while 7 were against it.</li> <li>• It was suggested that the scheme would disadvantage residents of Camden living on Hampstead Lane.</li> </ul>
What does this mean for us?	<p>The feedback from the statutory process was analysed and the proposal was approved. An outcome letter and works notice were distributed to residents and traders on 25 September 2008 with the scheme scheduled to come into operation on 20 October 2008.</p>
How were results communicated?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The results of the statutory consultation process were published on the Haringey Council website.</li> <li>• Leaflets distributed at the Statutory Notification stage also contained feedback on the results of the previous stage of consultation.</li> <li>• On 25 September 2008 those consulted during Statutory Notification received an outcome letter and works notice.</li> </ul>
