

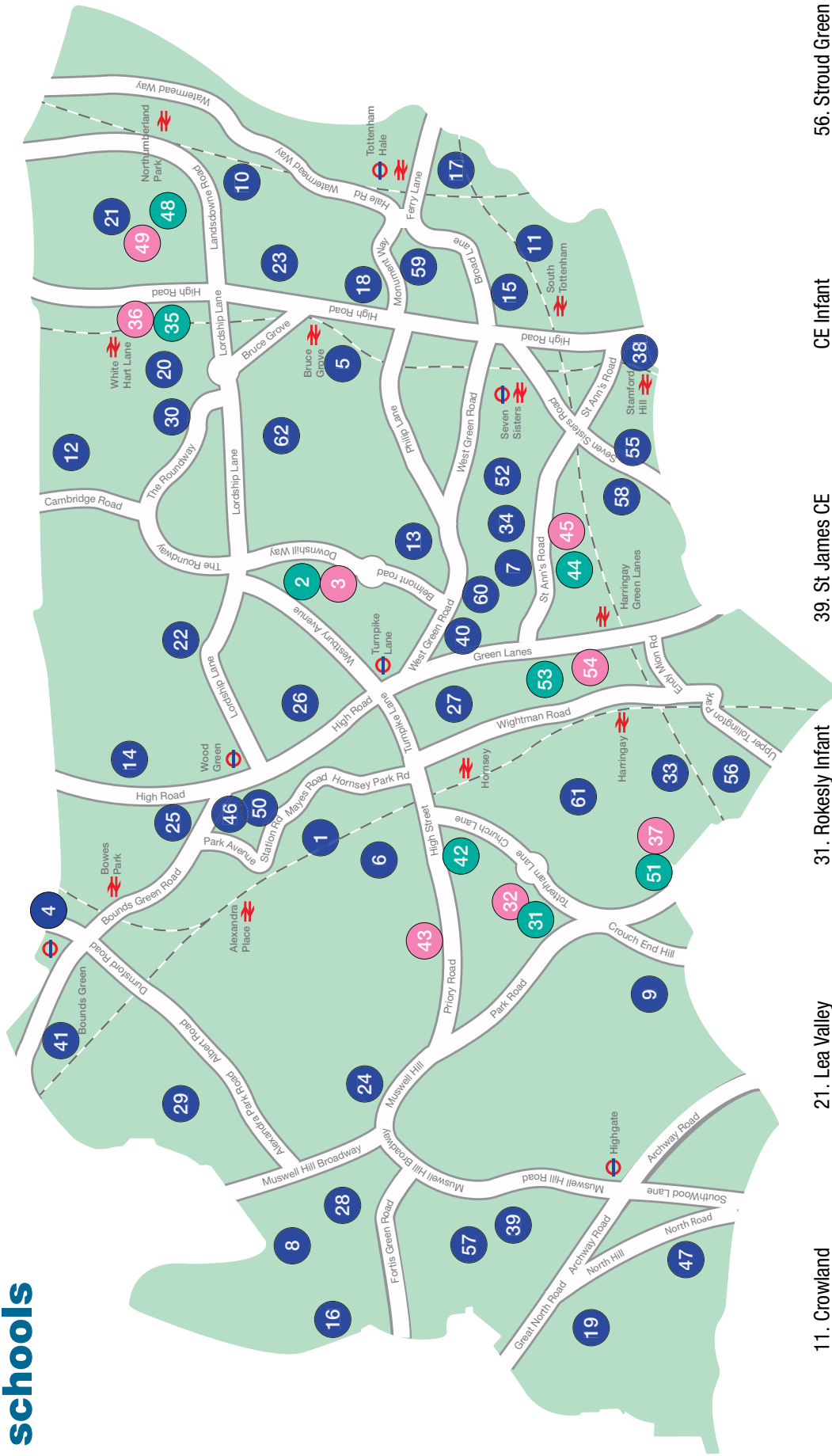

# Introduction

This booklet explains how to make an application for a reception or junior school place for September 2012.

## Reception Admissions 2012

If your child was born between 1 September 2007 and 31 August 2008, you will need to apply for a reception place for September 2012. Even if you want your child to start school later (the term after your child is five), you must still apply now within the timescales given in this booklet.

If your child was born between 1 September 2004 and 31 August 2005 and your child attends:
