

Feedback from Consultation
Richmond Road & Eleanor Road

Purpose of consultation:	To get the views of residents and businesses about having Richmond and Eleanor roads added to the proposed Bounds Green CPZ.
Methodology: (including number of returns/ response rate)	As part of the Public Consultation process we distributed 100 consultation documents to all residents and traders in both roads. We received 45 valid responses representing a 42% response rate.
Findings:	Of these 23 responses were received from Eleanor Road and 19 responses were received from Richmond Road. Eleanor Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 19 were in favour of the CPZ to include their road • 4 were opposed. Richmond Road: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 11 responses were in favour of the CPZ to include their road • 8 responses are opposed to the scheme.
What does this mean for us:	The feedback from the Public Consultation shows that there is support for the proposed Bounds Green CPZ to include Richmond Road & Eleanor Road. It is therefore recommended that the Cabinet approve the inclusion of these roads in the Bounds Green proposed area.
How were results communicated?	Results gathered from the Statutory process were included in the works notice that was sent out to all of those within the consultation area. Detailed street by street breakdowns of the consultation results are also available on the Haringey web site.
