## Have Your Say:

### Traffic Management in Rostrevor Avenue N15

Dear Resident,

The council has received complaints from some residents about traffic congestion and lack of parking space in Rostrevor Avenue. One concern is that at the High Road end, Rostrevor Avenue is too narrow for vehicles to pass each other safely and without risk of damage to parked vehicles. The other concern brought to our attention is that it is increasingly difficult to find parking space in this road.

Residents who contacted the council suggested two ways of dealing with these issues:

- Rostrevor Avenue and Craven Park Road to be made one-way in alternate directions. This would ease the congestion created by cars attempting to pass where the road is very narrow.
- The introduction of a Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) to prioritise parking for residents. This could assist by no longer allowing cars to be parked all day by, for instance, non residents such as commuters who use Stamford Hill and South Tottenham stations.

We would like to know the extent to which you and other residents of Rostrevor Avenue regard congestion and a lack of parking space as problems. Please let us know what you think by completing the attached response slip and sending it back to us using the freepost envelope provided.

Please note that this is simply an information-gathering exercise and no measures have either been defined or planned. The information you give will let us know whether there is likely demand for any traffic management measures.
