### What do we offer?

We offer a place for Haringey children that are into contemporary/popular music. There is a great spirit here, with tutors and children working together in an atmosphere of discovery and excitement. You can learn to sing and to play an instrument with regular public performances to put all your hard work into practice.

Small group lessons take place from 9.00am – 11.30am and there are opportunities to sing in our choir or play in rock and pop bands from 11.30am-12.30pm.

'Melody Shakers' is our new introduction to music class for younger students (school years 1-3) and also runs from 11.30am-12.30pm.

### Who are we?

The Saturday Morning Music Centre is run by Haringey Music and Performing Arts Centre and all tutors are experienced teachers already working in primary and secondary schools throughout the borough. As such, they have a unique insight into assessing the needs of local children as well as providing a creative and inclusive environment.

### How do I apply?

You need to be either resident in Haringey or attending a Haringey school. Currently, instrumental applicants need to be of school years 3-12 (age 7-18). Melody Shaker applicants need to be school years 1-3 (age 5-8). Apart from

drummers, all students need to have access to their chosen instruments for practice at home.

### When and where?

We are open from 9.00am -12.30pm on Saturday mornings.

We are normally open for 10 weeks of every school term.
