STATUTORY NOTIFICATION

Seven Sisters Controlled Parking Zone - proposed changes to existing parking restrictions

Dear Resident or Trader,

The council has identified a number of changes to existing restrictions in the Seven Sisters CPZ to make better use of parking bays for the benefit of residents and visitors to the area. The changes will maximise usage and provide short stay parking facilities for businesses and shoppers. We will also be introducing new double yellow lines at identified junctions to improve safety, particularly for pedestrians.

We are now proposing to make the changes and we are seeking your views on these proposals.

Our proposals consist of the following changes:

1. To change the existing:
 - (a) free parking bays on the east side of Arnold Road, N15 to residents' parking
 - (b) free parking bays on the north side of Colsterworth Road, N15 to shared use (Pay and Display and residents) parking
 - (c) free parking bays on the north side of Stainby Road, N15 outside Welbourne Primary School, to Pay and Display parking
 - (d) free parking bays on the south side of Tottenham Green East, N15 to shared use (business and residents) parking
 - (e) free parking bays located on the north side of Tynemouth Road, N15 outside the health centre, to Pay and Display parking
 - (f) residents bays located on the north side of Tynemouth Road, N15 outside the health centre to shared use (Pay and Display and residents) parking
 - (g) free parking bays located on both sides of Tynemouth Road, N15 near its junctions with Broad Lane, N15, to Pay and Display parking
 - (h) free parking bays located on the north side of Springfield Road, N15 near its junctions with Broad Lane, N15 to a loading bay
 - (i) free parking bays located on the east side of Cunningham Road, N15 near its junction with Broad Lane, to business parking
 - (j) free parking bays located on the east side of Stamford Road, N15 to residents' parking bays
 - (k) free parking bays located on the south side of Pages Green Road, N15 to business and loading bays

- (l) remove the existing free bay in Herbert Road, N15 located on the north side, west of No. 34 Herbert Road and replace with a single yellow line
 - (m) loading bays in Walton Road, N15 to residents' parking
 - (n) free parking bays in Wakefield Road, N15 to shared use parking (business and residents)
 - (o) free parking bays in Rangemore Road, N15 to shared use parking (business and Pay and Display)
 - (p) business parking bay located on the north side of Earlsmead Road, N15 to residents' parking
 - (q) shared use bays (business and residents) in Pages Green Terrace, N15 to shared use parking (Pay and Display, residents and business)
 - (r) free parking bays on Pages Green Terrace, N15 to Pay and Display parking
 - (s) free parking bay on Bristall Road, N15 to residents' parking
 - (t) free parking bays on the west side of Kirkton Road, N15 to Pay and Display parking
2. Shorten the existing Pay and Display bay located between outside Nos. 41 and 47 West Green Road, and replace it with double yellow lines.
3. Introduce waiting restrictions in the form of double yellow lines at the following locations which operate at any time:
- (a) Seaford Road, N15 at its junctions with Braemar Road.
 - (b) Brunswick Road, N15 at its junction with West Green Road.
 - (c) Grove Park Road, N15 at its junction with West Green Road.
 - (d) Beaconsfield Road, N15 at its junction with West Green Road.
 - (e) Braemar Road, N15 at its junction with Roslyn Road.
 - (f) Houghton Road, N15 at its junction with West Green Road.
 - (g) Pages Green Road, N15 at its junction with Stamford Road.
 - (h) Suffield Road, N15 at its junction with West Green Road.
 - (i) Antill Road, N15 at its junction with the western arm of Montague Road.
 - (j) Arnold Road, N15 at its junction with Philip Lane.

Have your say

To enable any parking alterations to be legally enforceable the Council is required to enter into a stage of consultation known as Statutory Notification. This is the legal part of the process and takes the form of a public notice advertised in the local press, London Gazette and displayed in visible locations within the area to inform members of the public of the Council's intentions.

The legal notice will be advertised on **18 February 2010** and provides a 21-day consultation period for interested parties to make representations regarding our proposals outlined in this document. The closing date for comments is **11 March 2010**.

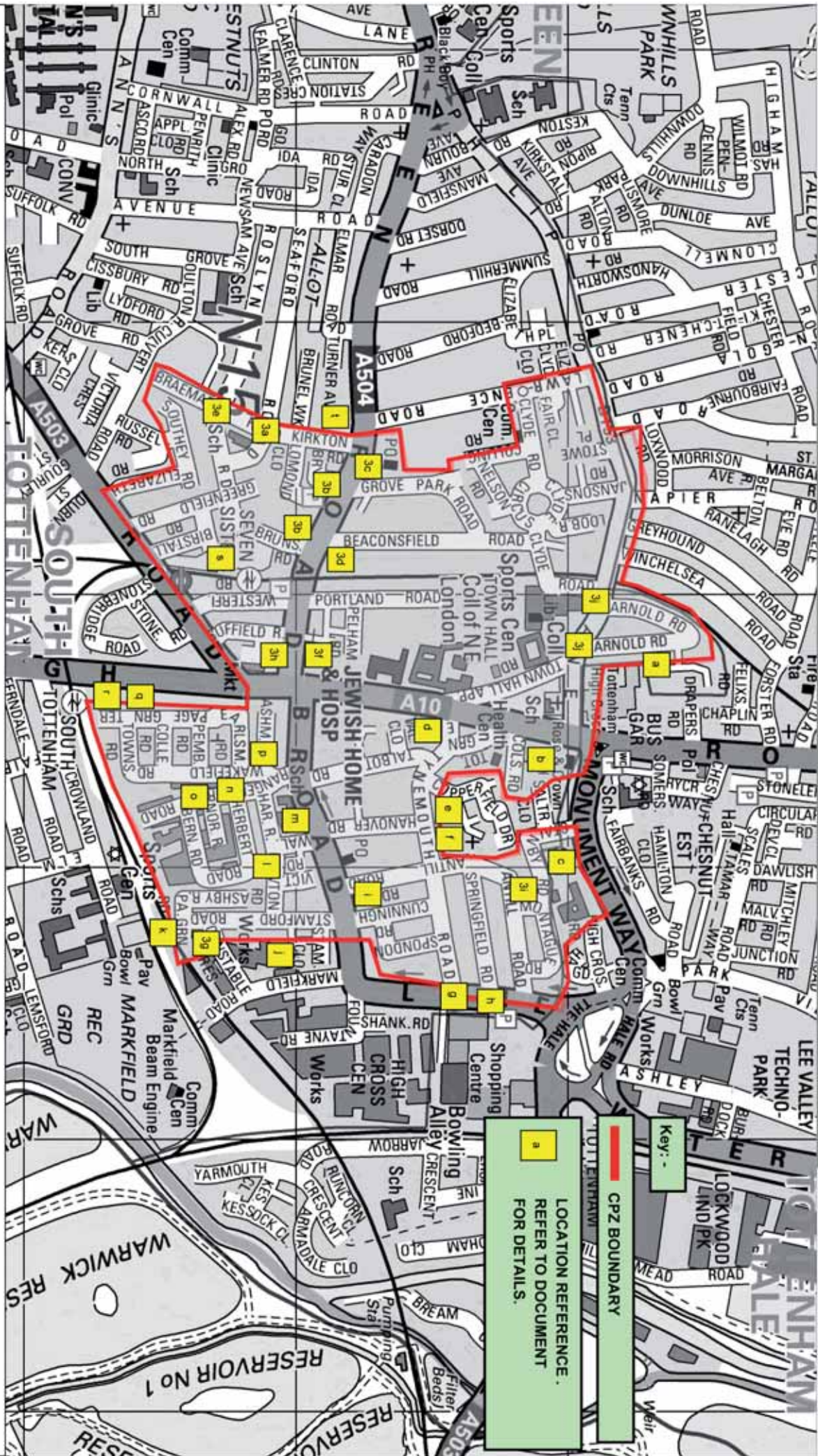

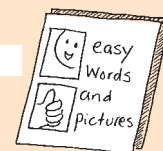
