Dear Resident or Business,

We are writing to you about the parking controls which were introduced in your area in 2014.

These measures were brought in to tackle growing parking congestion, and to support the ongoing regeneration of Tottenham, by ensuring traffic continues to flow smoothly and there are enough places to park as the volume of traffic travelling through the area increases.
