Autism Support for children under 12

Autism Pathway for under 12

1. Referral received

Usually this has been sent by your school SENCo, SLT or GP.

2. Triage

Decision made about appropriate pathway and acceptance letter sent out.

3. Waiting list

We provide information and advice about the support available while you're waiting.

4. Assessment

This could be within SLT sessions or a separate appointment.

6. Feedback

We will feed back strengths, differences and difficulties and the outcome of the assessment. You will be given a pack with local information and support.

7. Report

A summary of the assessment and feedback will be sent to you, nursery/school, GP and anyone else that you think is useful.

8. Discharge

Your child will be discharged from the social communication team but may be followed up by the doctors if there are any medical concerns.
