




The Council will require the provision of allotment sites as part of any new large development and will also seek to identify potential new sites from existing pockets of land in areas of deficiency. Amend existing 5 th sentence: Change '.....further thought must be given to increasing allotment provision.....' to '....the council will seek to increase allotment provision....' Final existing sentence add : Noel Park, Stroud Green and West Green.	While it is recognised that with existing pressures on land these levels may be difficult to achieve, these requirements should be included, otherwise opportunities to increase allotment provision will be missed, and the situation will never improve. There are no plots in Noel Park, only 27 plots in Stroud Green, and only 42 plots in West Green.
