NHS Test and Trace Self-Isolation Payment

You could get up to £500 if you have been told to self-isolate via NHS Test and Trace and your income is affected.

Please note, fully vaccinated people identified as a contact of a person with COVID-19 don't need to selfisolate, so won't qualify for a selfisolation payment unless they test positive themselves.

FAMILIES AND CHILDREN

We know that raising a young family can be financially challenging, but there is help and support available.

Healthy Start Vouchers

If you're pregnant or have a child under 4, you could get weekly vouchers to buy milk, baby formula, fruit, vegetables, and pulses.

Free School Meals (FSM) and School Uniform Grant

Your child/children may be able to get FSM if you're the parent/guardian and in receipt of qualifying benefits.

If eligible for FSM, you can also apply for a one-off £60 clothing grant to buy school clothes and shoes for your child.

Free Early Learning/Education

Up to 15 hours of Free Early Learning is available for parents of two-yearolds who are receiving financial support, and all three- and four-year olds.

Working parents of three- and fouryear-olds could also get 30 hours free childcare.
