Engaging Families from more affluent backgrounds

We've started having conversations with schools in different areas of the Borough to see how we tailor our offers to meet the local need. We are continuing to raise our profile to professionals in those areas of Haringey.

Families do not always give consent for referrals

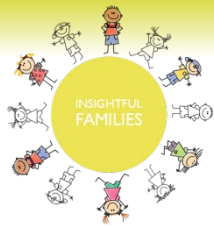
We understand that a lot of the work is getting families to acknowledge their issues. Having curiosity and asking questions to evoke discussions and planting seeds is something we can support you with.

Providing support throughout all locations in the Borough

We are providing support across the Borough with a more outward facing model, seeing families within their homes and within their communities. These conferences are being held in Tottenham, Highgate and Alexandra Palace

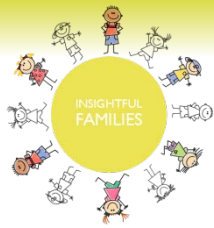
Meeting the needs of the families including childcare or work commitments

We provide services in the evening (outside of office hours) and we are developing links with Children Centres to aid the provision of childcare. We are continuously working with our families through co-production for the ongoing development of the Service.

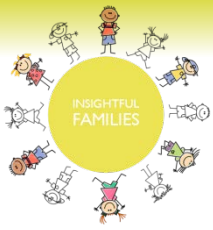

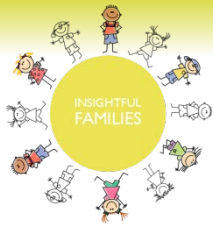
