

# Conflict that occurs between parents/ carers that is frequent, intense and poorly resolved.



## The Programme

#### A small change in service delivery could have a big impact

#### We want to work together and support you to integrate a focus on parental conflict by:

- Trialling Face to Face interventions for mothers and fathers in intact and separated families, in four areas (led by Hertfordshire, Westminster, Gateshead and Dorset)
- Helping local areas to develop solutions and strategies to meet the needs of the families they work with by providing Strategic
   Leadership Support and Practitioner Training grants to local authorities
- Working closely with the Department of Health and Social Care and Public Health England to address the issue of alcohol misuse, which is often a major contributor to parental conflict. Together we are delivering a joint £6m package of support aimed at improving the outcomes of children of alcohol-dependent parents, including a £4.5m **Innovation Fund** which is delivering projects in 9 local authority areas.
- A Challenge Fund, which recently awarded £2.2m of grant funding to 10 innovative projects to gather learning on what works to reduce parental conflict digitally and for families where the children face other disadvantages
- Sharing learning and providing support through our team of Regional Integration Leads and a series of regional and national network events
