### **The London Borough of Haringey (Wards Corner Regeneration Project) Compulsory Purchase Order 2016**

**WHEREAS** the London Borough of Haringey has submitted to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government, for confirmation of an Order made by them under section 226 (1)(a) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and the Acquisition of Land Act 1981, which would authorise them to acquire compulsorily the land referred to in the Schedule hereto for the purpose of facilitating the carrying out of development, redevelopment or improvement on or in relation to the land.
