

The Referral Process (VI Team)

- 1. <u>Refer</u> hospital/school refer child using Haringey Referral Form (or hospital letter) once medical diagnosis received.
- Case assigned Case is reviewed by the VI team and allocated to a Qualified Teacher of Children and Young People with a Vision Impairment (QTVI)
- 3. <u>Initial visit</u> by team at home, school, college to meet pupil, parents, SENCo and relevant school staff to gather information
- 4. <u>Second visit</u> to assess functional vision and provide written report that includes advice/strategies for teaching staff (this can sometimes be done on the first visit). Notify other professionals if necessary (e.g., Habilitation Specialist)
- Visit frequency calculate NatSIP (National Sensory Impairment Partnership) score to determine frequency of visits
- 6. **Training** further staff training as and when required
- 7. Regular visits add to regular visit cycle
- 8. **Review NatSIP scores** annual review of NatSIP score to amend frequency of visits if necessary
