# OUTCOME OF STATUTORY NOTIFICATION – WORKS NOTICE **EXPANSION OF HARINGEY CAR CLUB SCHEME**

Dear Resident,

You may recall receiving our statutory notification inviting comments on proposals to introduce 42 new and additional car club spaces in various locations across the borough.

We are grateful to the 95 residents who made comments and representations and interested to note the strong support shown by so many towards car club expansion. Having considered all representations as part of the decision-making process on car club expansion, the council has approved 40 new car club bays at the locations listed on the next page.

**There will be one new bay at each of these locations:**

**The following locations will each have two new bays:**

Hatherley Gardens N8	Hurst Avenue N6
Parkland Road N22	Salisbury Road N22
Sheldon Avenue N6	Tudor Close N6

Parkland Road N22 will have a further two bays with charging points for electric vehicles (EV).

The council has decided not to go ahead with the car club bays proposed for Princes Avenue N22, and Nelson Road N8. Detailed location plans of all bays are available on the Council's website.

**When will the bays be ready?**

The council will start work on the bays immediately and expects this to be completed for all locations within a month. We will make every effort to keep any works-based disruption to a minimum. Delivery of the car club vehicles will start when the bays are ready.

Residents should be aware that only car club vehicles may occupy these bays. Unauthorised vehicles will receive a Penalty Charge Notice and be subject to removal.

## Joining the car club

Car club vehicles in Haringey are operated by Streetcar (a Zipcar company). Before using these vehicles you will need to purchase Streetcar membership which costs £59.95 for one year. To celebrate the expansion of the car club scheme, Streetcar is offering Haringey residents £30 free driving credit if they join the scheme before the end of August. To take advantage of this offer please quote '**HARINGEY 30**' when you apply to join. Full information is available online at [www.streetcar.com](http://www.streetcar.com) or you can telephone Streetcar on **0845 644 8475**.

The simple steps to join the car club and book a vehicle are:

- Register with streetcar to receive a smartcard and PIN number.
- Book your car out for any duration from an hour upwards.
- Swipe your smartcard to gain access to your car and enter the PIN number.
- Return the car to its dedicated parking bay when you are finished.

Not only is it easy to use but Streetcar offers a choice of vehicles to members ranging from VW Golf, Polo, BMW Series One, to VW Touran People Carriers and Transporter vans. Vehicles can be hired for just an hour or for longer periods of up to 6 months.

Haringey's car club scheme offers Streetcar members access to 67 cars and vans, along with 7 off-road vehicles. The expanded service means there are now car club bays at many more convenient locations across the borough.

## Future developments

As car club membership and demand continue to grow, the Council plans further expansion with the intention that every resident and business will be within a 5 minute walk of a car club vehicle.

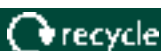
