Reorganisation of Finsbury Park Controlled Parking Zones

Dear Resident or Trader

As you may be aware we notified residents and businesses in May 2011 of our intention to introduce three new CPZs from the existing Finsbury Park CPZ. The aim of the proposal is to prevent intra-CPZ commuter parking within the Finsbury Park CPZ.

I now write to thank all those who commented on the proposals and to inform you that details of feedback can be found in the Council's report which is available on our website under Environment & Transport > Parking > Parking consultations > Recent parking consultations. Having studied the feedback in detail, the Council has decided, with some small modifications, to introduce the changes as proposed.

If your road becomes part of either the new Finsbury Park 'B' or Finsbury Park 'C' zones as a result of the changes, your parking permits will be updated automatically and posted to you. If you do not receive your new permit by 30 September, please email parking@haringey.gov.uk advising of your details and we will respond within 48 hours. If you do not have access to email please contact Customer Services on 0208 489 1000. Please note that any unused visitor permits you have previously purchased will need to be changed before the new arrangements take effect. This can only be done by post as personal applications will **not** be processed at any of our Customer Service Centres. Therefore any unused visitor permits must be sent to: Haringey Council Parking Services, PO Box 55235, London N22 9DF

Work to modify the signs and carry out line marking is planned to take place between **29 August and 30 September 2011** subject to weather conditions. Legal notices will be published on **25 August 2011** and copies displayed in the local area and the revised parking arrangements will come into effect on **14 October 2011**.
