Anyone wishing to oppose the application must give notice in writing to the Licensing Team, Units 271-272 Lee Valley Technopark, Ashley Road, Tottenham, London, N17 9LN **WITHIN 28 DAYS OF THIS NOTICE**, specifying the grounds of opposition.

Petitions must bear the prayer of that petition on each page and a warning to potential signatories that a copy of the petition will be supplied by the Council to the applicant. Each person signing should also print their name and address, preferably in black ink. Each page of the petition should be dated.

Persons objecting to the granting of a Licence must be prepared to attend in person at a public hearing before the Council's Planning Applications and Miscellaneous Function Committee.

This notice must be completed and, on the same day on which the application is made, must be exhibited on a conspicuous part of the premises where it can be easily seen and read by people

in the street. The notice must be kept exhibited for no less than 28 days.
