



**LICENSING ACT 1991
SPECIAL TREATMENT LICENCE
EXHIBITION OF A NOTICE AT THE PREMISES**

On the date on which application is made for a special treatment licence, the applicant is required (where appropriate) to put up a notice at the premises in a place where it can be easily seen and read by people in the street or adjoining public areas. The notice must be kept exhibited for 28 days.

A copy of the prescribed notice (which will require completion) is enclosed. The notice must be dated to show the day it was first exhibited.

Will you kindly notify, on the form below, the date on which the notice was exhibited and give an undertaking that it will be kept exhibited for 28 days. Please return this form with your completed application form.
