

**LONDON BOROUGH OF HARINGEY
LOCAL AUTHORITIES (ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION IN
DESIGNATED PUBLIC PLACES) REGULATIONS 2007**

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** under Regulation 5 of the Local Authorities (Alcohol Consumption in Designated Public Places) Regulations 2007 that the London Borough of Haringey (the 'Council') in exercise of its powers under those Regulations proposes to make an order identifying the places detailed in the schedule below.
2. The Order allows a constable and other accredited persons under section 41, section 42 and schedule 5 to the Police Reform Act to require a person, in a designated place, not to drink alcohol in that place if the officer reasonably believes that a person has consumed alcohol or intends to do so, and to surrender the alcohol and any opened or sealed containers in the person's possession. Any person who fails without reasonable excuse to comply with a constable's request under this provision may commit an offence and be liable to prosecution.
3. A place is not a "designated public place" (and therefore the powers within the Order do not apply) for these purposes if it is:
 - (i) premises in respect of which there is a premises licence under the Licensing Act 2003 (the 2003 Act) authorising the premises to be used for the sale or supply of alcohol, and
 - (ii) premises in respect of which there is a club premises certificate under the 2003 Act certifying that the premises may be used by the club for the sale or supply of alcohol, and
 - (iii) a place within the curtilage of any premises in (i) or (ii) above, and
 - (iv) premises which by virtue of Part 5 of the 2003 Act may for the time being be used for the supply of alcohol which, by virtue of that Part, could have been so used within the last 30 minutes, and
 - (v) a place where facilities or activities relating to the sale or consumption of alcohol are for the time being permitted by virtue of a permission granted under section 115E of the Highways Act 1980 (highway related uses).
