Statutory Notification

Proposed Bus Stands in Ashley Road and Burdock Road, N17

Dear Business,

You may recall being consulted in August on proposals to install bus stands on Ashley Road and Burdock Road. London Buses requested the bus stands because of the urgent need for additional bus standing space in the Tottenham Hale area.

Feedback to the proposals indicated concern at possible obstruction as a result of buses parking on Ashley Road. As a result we have made the following alterations to the original proposals:

- We now intend to relocate the previously proposed bus stand outside Ashley House further south towards Watermead Way.
- The stand further North on Ashley Road will remain in the same position but, in order to increase the carriageway width, we will introduce double yellow lines with 'blips' opposite the bus stand. These will enforce no waiting or loading at any time in this area.

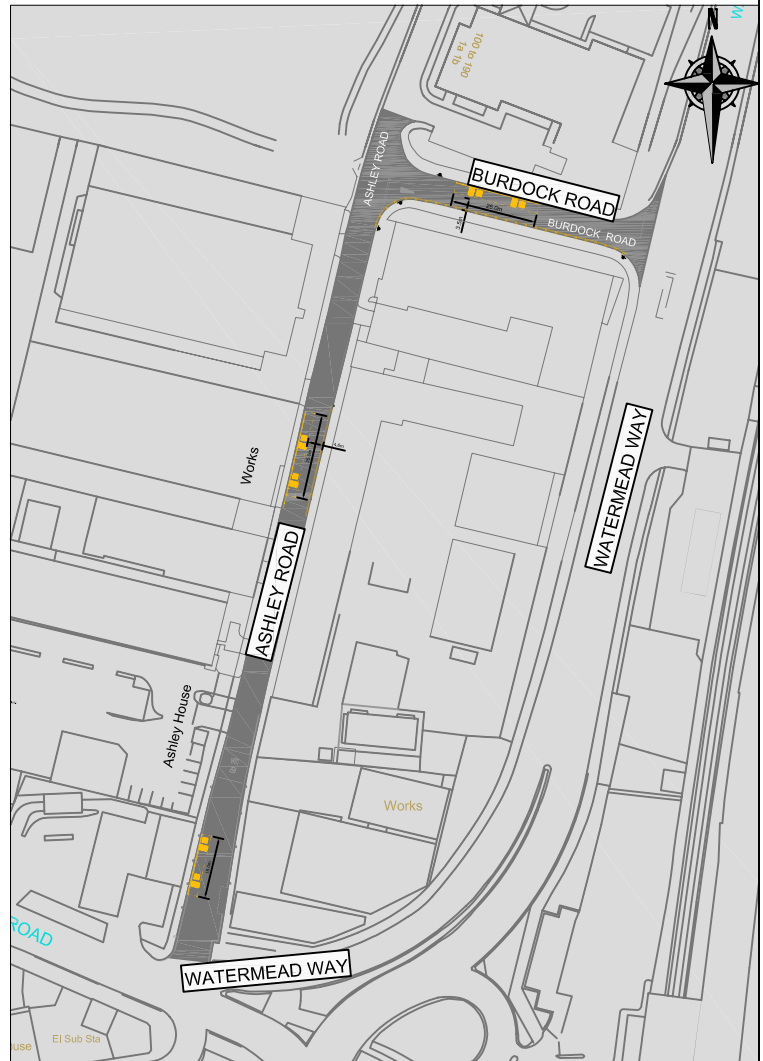
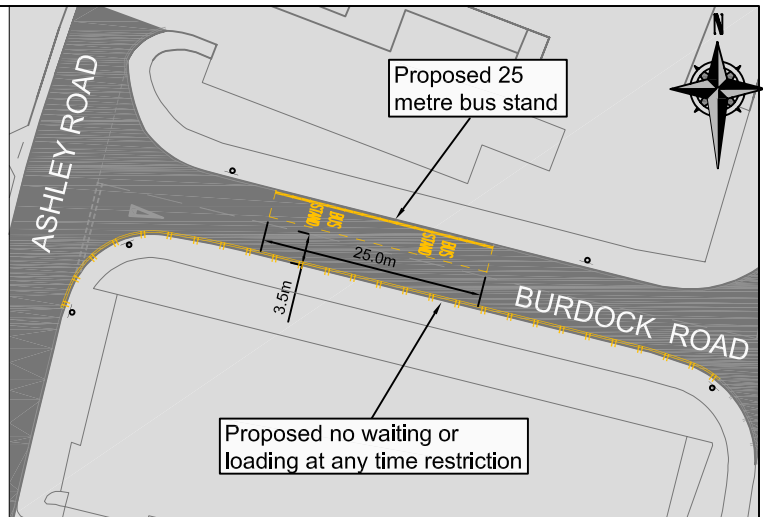
The proposal to locate a bus stand on the northern side of Burdock Road will remain as originally planned and to avoid congestion we intend putting double yellow lines with 'blips' on the opposite side of the road to ensure no waiting or loading at any time.

Full details of the revised proposals measures are set out on the attached plan.

This notification marks the start of a three week period during which we welcome your views, comments and 'representations'. Please ensure that we receive your views no later than 10 November, so that we can consider all feedback before making a decision. If a decision is taken to go ahead with the proposals, the waiting restrictions would be likely to take effect on 24 November; or shortly thereafter.
