# STATUTORY NOTIFICATION

## Woodside Area Parking Consultation – Proposed extension of the Wood Green Outer Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) and the introduction of the Woodside CPZ

Dear Resident or Trader,

In September/October 2009, we carried out a consultation to ascertain whether parking issues existed in the Woodside ward by inviting you to give your views regarding parking problems in your road. We would like to thank everyone who responded.

The purpose of this letter is to feed back the results we received from the public consultation. We would also like to inform you of our proposals following the consultation.

### What did the consultation tell us?

We distributed 1195 consultation leaflets and received a total of 292 valid responses. This represents a 24% response rate from the entire consultation area. The responses indicated that an overall majority of 61% (179) were against the introduction of parking controls.

The consultation document stated that the purpose of the consultation was not a proposal to introduce a controlled parking zone to the entire area consulted within the Woodside ward, but rather to identify areas where there was support for parking controls. We therefore analysed the feedback on a road-by-road basis to help identify roads and areas in favour of parking controls and those who objected. On further analysis, it was found there were a number of roads in support of the introduction of parking controls that will be subject to further statutory consultation.

### Our proposals

In line with our commitment to listen to the local community's parking concerns, we are proposing to introduce parking controls to an area that has demonstrated support, as shown on the attached plan.

While the response from Saxon, Eldon and Fife Road indicated opposition to parking controls, they are being included in the proposals as they will inevitably experience displacement parking otherwise and their inclusion will result in a cohesive area. This does however give residents a final opportunity to support or object to our proposals.

The proposals consist of:

- **An extension of the Wood Green CPZ Outer Zone (operational from 8am to 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday) to include the following roads:**
  - Perth Road (the uncontrolled section)
  - Fife Road
- **The introduction of the Woodside CPZ (operational from 8am to 6:30pm, Monday to Friday) to include the following roads:**



- **Eldon Road**
  - **Granville Road (From its junction with Lordship Lane to Eldon Road)**
  - **Melrose Avenue**
  - **Saxon Road**
  - **Paisley Road**
  - **Elm Road** – Elm Road is a private road and will not be included in the CPZ. You have been sent this letter so you are aware of what may be happening in local roads.
- The introduction of double yellow lines to several junctions within and outside the proposed CPZ areas. The double yellow lines will help improve turning movements for motorists, particularly emergency vehicles by removing obstructive parking. The double yellow lines will also facilitate visibility for both pedestrians and motorists.
  - The introduction of two bus stop markings along Perth Road on the north and south bound sides of the road outside 91-97 and 52-60 respectively.

### **What happens next?**

We are required to enter into this stage of consultation to enable any parking controls to be legally enforceable. This is the legal part of the process and takes the form of a Public Notice advertised in the local press, London Gazette and displayed in visible locations within the area to inform you of the Council's intentions.

The legal notice will be advertised on **11 February 2010** and provides a 21-day consultation period for interested parties to make representations regarding our proposal to implement parking controls. The closing date for comments is **4 March 2010**.

You should note that statutory notification differs from public consultation in that any interested party can make representations, rather than restricting the consultation to a specified area. Responses are also analysed according to the comments made, rather than based on "Yes/No" responses.

**Please remember it is very important that you do provide reasons as to whether you are in favour of or object to our proposals.**

Your feedback will help inform us whether residents in your road would like to be included in a CPZ. **All representations will be considered by the Cabinet at its meeting of 23 March 2010 before a final decision is taken on these proposals.**

If we receive a high proportion of valid objections, we may not introduce a CPZ on your road. However, you should note that this could mean that your road suffers from displacement parking if the other roads consulted support parking controls. It is therefore important that if you are in support of our proposals, you provide us with your views.

If there are no formal objections to the proposals, we will send you a further notice informing you when works will begin on site and when the scheme will come into effect. We will also send you a permit application form at this time.

**It is important to note that if you live on a road outside the proposed CPZ areas, you will not receive any further correspondence regarding this issue as your road is not included in this CPZ proposal.** We have sent you this letter to inform you of what may be happening in local roads.

Thank you in advance for taking the time to read this letter. We hope that you will respond with any views you have on the proposal, to ensure we can consider them as part of this process.

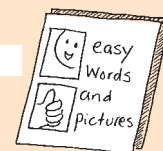
