Section 6. Conditions of permission

- 1. No Skip or materials are to be deposited on the highway until permission has been obtained.
- 2. A builder's skip shall be clearly marked with the owners name and number.
- 3. Skips and materials must be properly lighted during the hours of darkness.
- 4. Full information regarding the positioning of a skip and the manner in which materials may be deposited on the highway is obtainable with this application, can be supplied upon request and will be provided with a licence when issued.
- 5. If necessary, we make ask you to remove/relocate your skip in order to allow works on the highway to take place.
- 6. If you specifically require space to be reserved for locating a skip and /or building materials within a Parking Bay, you will need to apply to for a suspension of a Parking Bay.
