How to pay your Council Tax

Payments are due on or before the 1st of each month unless you pay by direct debit. You must allow enough time when making your payment for the Council to receive it by the due date.



You can now pay your council tax by direct debit on the 1st, 15th or 25th of the month. You can set up a direct debit online at www.haringey.gov.uk/myaccount, or phone 020 8489 1000. Please ensure you have your bank account details to hand.

24 hour Automated Telephone Payment Service - Just phone 0300 456 0520 and follow the instructions to make a payment by debit or credit card.

On line payments - Just go to www.haringey.gov.uk/myaccount and follow the instructions to make payment by debit or credit card.
