The council has started work to upgrade tenants and leaseholders' homes on Noel Park estate.

We're aiming to replace 238 outdated modular bathroom pods and 56 kitchen extensions throughout the duration of the project to ensure that they meet the decent homes standard. Currently 25 modular pods have been completed with another 26 under way and more will be upgraded in the coming months.






Beware of bogus callers!
