## LONDON BOROUGH OF HARINGEY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER 2024 No.55

### The Haringey (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No.21) Order 2024

Made: 27th September 2024

Coming into force: 3rd October 2024

The London Borough of Haringey, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 45, 46, 49, 51 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**) as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Traffic Management Act 2014 and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:

## **Citation and commencement**

This Order may be cited as the Haringey (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No.21)
 Order 2024 and shall come into force on 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2024.

#### **Interpretation**

- (1) In this Order:
   "the Order of 2021" means The Haringey (Charged-For Parking Places) Order 2021(b).
  - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
  - (3) Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2021 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

## Amendment to the Order of 2021

- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the Order of 2021 shall have effect as though:
  - (a) the expression 'essential service provider' in Article 3(1) to that Order be substituted with the following expression set out below:

"essential service provider" means either:-

- a person or organisation providing services on the behalf of the Council, including the Council itself, its partners and contractors; or
- (b) a person or organisation providing services on the behalf of a health authority, including NHS health professionals, partners and contractors; or
- (c) charities and not-for profit organisations recognised by the Council as providing healthcare, counselling or social care to Haringey residents; or
- (d) a person or organisation involved in the delivery of essential services to residents who are required to work extended unsociable hours or are on 24 hour call out; or
- (e) qualifying school staff, assessed on a case by case basis; or
- (f) ministers of religion undertaking home visits within the London Borough of Haringey; or
- (g) for whom the use of a vehicle is essential to the carrying out of their duties;
- (h) foster carers appointed by the Council to provide temporary custody or guardianship for children under the age of 15 years, whose parents are unable to look after them.
- 4. the item numbered 5 in Schedule 3 of that Order shall be substituted with the details set out below:-

5. Essential service permits

5. The charge for an essential service permit referred to in Article 27(3), in relation the CO<sub>2</sub> emissions (in respect of vehicles registered after 01 March 2001) or engine size (in respect of vehicles registered before 01 March 2001), and fuel type of the vehicle in respect of

which the permit is applied for, shall be as follows:-

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

## (This is not part of the Order but used to help explain its purpose) The Haringey (Charged-For Parking Places) (Amendment No.21) Order 2024

The general effect of the Order, is to make the following changes to the Essential Service Permit (ESP) to facilitate those who need to use a motor vehicle to deliver essential services to Haringey residents:

- a) ESPs issued to Council staff will be transferrable
- b) ESP charges will increase by inflation (10%) and a new £80 surcharge will be applied to diesel fuelled vehicles, see Schedule below.
- c) Schools are to be removed from the reduced (concessionary) charge ESP scheme. An annual allocation of transferable school (ESP) permits, which can be allocated as and when required, will be made available to schools that are Ofsted-registered and have an up-to-date School Travel Plan. The permit will be limited in use to specific streets close to the school. It is proposed that an allocation of 10 ESPs is made available at a charge of £200 per permit annually. Those requiring a higher allocation will be limited in total to 20 per school. Each additional permit (above the standard 10 allocation) will attract a surcharge of £100 per annum.
- d) Foster carers appointed by the Council to provide temporary custody or guardianship for children under the age of 15 years, whose parents are unable to look after them will be eligible to apply for an ESP at a reduced (concessionary) charge.

**Notice is hereby given** that the Council of the London Borough of Haringey on 27<sup>th</sup> September 2024 has made the above mentioned Order under sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

The general effect of the Order: To make the following changes to the Essential Service Permit (ESP) to facilitate those who need to use a motor vehicle to deliver essential services to Haringey residents:

- d) Foster carers appointed by the Council to provide temporary custody or guardianship for children under the age of 15 years, whose parents are unable to look after them will be eligible to apply for an ESP at a reduced (concessionary) charge.

Date of operation: The Orders will come into operation on 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2024.

**Application to the high court:** Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it does not comply with the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made there under have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
