We are excited to announce that our new demonstration modular extension has been set up in The Sandlings, which is adjacent to 164-183 N22 6XS, behind the car park. Residents can now view this over the next three to four months.

A full-size replica of the modular extension, which will be fitted to many homes throughout Noel Park, contains a fitted bathroom with a basin, bath, toilet, radiator and openable window. There is also a fitted kitchen with wall and base units including appliances on display (toaster, kettle, microwave, fridge freezer) to give residents a better idea of what their home will look like.

For properties on **Gladstone Avenue**, we are in the final stages of receiving planning permission from Haringey Council's Planning department. We will be in touch directly with residents prior to any work taking place.

Haringey Works

We are committed to ensuring residents are supported into employment during the Noel Park major works programme. Through Haringey Works, a service dedicated to helping Haringey residents find jobs, we have recruited six local apprentices to join the local major works team.

Apprentices James and Tairone (right), are working alongside our contractor EQUANS', learning skills related to building site management. Tairone was born and raised in Wood Green.



Christine and Michelle joined the customer service team as apprentices to help answer queries from residents about the programme. Both have since gone on to find full time employment. All apprentices recruited in Haringey are paid the London Living Wage.

Cllr Ruth Gordon, Cabinet member for Housebuilding, Placemaking, and Development at Haringey Council, said:

"We are committed to helping young people into skilled and better-paid work. Haringey Works has been set up to provide careers advice and link residents with potential employers. The council also makes sure that apprenticeships and commitments to employ Haringey residents are embedded into its contracts. We have invested £238 million of council contracts with local businesses. Haringey Works is part of the council's community wealth building strategy. The borough is not short of talented young people in Haringey and therefore we want to make sure as many as possible get a chance to reach their potential."


