Admission arrangements for Haringey community and voluntary controlled (VC) schools for 2025-26 and proposed planned admission number (PAN) reduction

Haringey is consulting on:

- Proposed admission arrangements for entry to school in the academic year 2025/26 for community and voluntary controlled, nursery, infant, junior, primary, secondary and sixth form settings
- Proposed co-ordinated schemes for admission of children to Year 7 and Reception in September 2025
- Proposed In-year Fair Access Protocol for the year starting 1 March 2024 which all Haringey schools and academies must follow
- Proposed reductions of 1 form of entry (30 places) at several primary school

Many London boroughs are continuing to re-balance the supply of school places against lower demand and this theme also applies to Haringey in 2023. Demand for primary school places has consistently fallen in recent years and our future projections for demand show a further fall. The council is therefore consulting on the proposal to reduce the planned admission number (PAN) for the following primary schools:
