Funding Early Years Education

The Stage 2 consultation closed on 20th January, results will be published online by Friday 17th February.

National Consultation Update

On the 1st December 2016, the Government published its response to the national consultation on a funding formula for early years. As part of this an operational guidance document explains how the DfE expects the free entitlement for 3 & 4 year olds to be funded and supported by local authorities. We have also been given information about the funding allocation that Haringey Council will receive in 2016/17 for the delivery of the universal free entitlement for 3 & 4 year olds, the additional 15 hours and the 15 hours free entitlement for eligible 2 year old.
