## Alexandra Palace Parking Survey: Feedback and Information

Dear Resident or Business,

We would like to thank those who participated in the recent survey which asked if there was a need for further consultation on parking controls. We received over 450 responses to the survey and a majority (54%) told us they did not see any need for further consultation. A report of survey results by road is available on the *current parking consultations* page of the website.

We can confirm that we will not be consulting further except for two roads which have expressed ongoing and consistent support for parking controls. Survey responses from Dagmar Road were 88% in favour of consultation on the introduction of controls, and Crescent Road showed 67% support.

Both roads have, on three previous occasions, requested parking controls and the council will be consulting on a proposal to extend the existing CPZ into Crescent and Dagmar roads under what is known as 'an experimental' traffic management order (TMO). Experimental TMOs give us the flexibility to review and make changes where necessary to controls. A consultation letter with full information is being circulated to residents of Crescent Road and Dagmar Road.

Given that a substantial majority of residents in roads around Alexandra Palace CPZ do not see any need for parking controls, the council will not be conducting any further parking consultations in this area until the next formal parking review is undertaken.
