

## Frontline Consultation

### Hornsey North area: Assessing Demand for Consultation on a Possible CPZ:

In April 2017, letters were delivered to residents (and businesses) in roads defined as being in 'Hornsey North' – that is north of Priory Road close to the existing Horney South Controlled Parking Zone CPZ). The letters asked residents to indicate whether or not a full consultation is required on the need for parking controls in their area. The survey was conducted online only. The online form provided for responses was a replica of the familiar freepost feedback card which is quick and easy to complete. Furthermore a QR code was printed on the letters sent to residents and this ready access to the relevant web page and online form.
