

The Haringey (Prescribed Routes) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2021


Made: 1 February 2021

Coming into force: 4 February 2021

The Council of the London Borough of Haringey, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of powers conferred by section 6 and 124 and Part IV to Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into force on 4 February 2021 and may be cited as The Haringey (Prescribed Routes) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2021.
2. In this Order:-
"2016 Regulations" means The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
"pedal cycle" has the same meaning as in the 2016 Regulations.
"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
3. Save as provided in Article 4 of this order, no person shall cause any vehicle to enter or proceed in that length of Warwick Gardens N4, at its junction with St. Ann's Road, operating at any time.
4. Nothing in Article 3 above shall apply:
 - (a) Pedal cycle; or
 - (b) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency; or
 - (c) to any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to section 66 or section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
