Works Notice: Ferry Lane Road Closures

Dear Resident or Business,

As part of the ongoing Ferry Lane works to improve the public realm and make it a more pleasant route for pedestrians and cyclists, temporary overnight road closures will be in place for up to two nights from 28 July and then for two nights from 5 August. This is to allow our Highways Contractor to remove the LED 'razor light' column at Tottenham Lock. A further road closure will be required in September to carry out road resurfacing work. Information is set out below and on the attached plans.

The temporary road closures of Ferry Lane will operate between its junctions with Mill Mead Road and Blackhorse Lane. Access will be maintained for residents. Planned dates are as follows:

LED Razor Lights Works

(I) **Overnight closure of Ferry Lane on Tuesday 28th July from 9pm to 5am.** If additional time is required, then the road will also be closed overnight Wednesday 29th July from 9pm to 5am.

(II) **Closure of Ferry Lane for two nights starting 9pm Saturday 15 August and ending at 5am on Monday 17 August.** If the work can be completed earlier, then it may be possible to reopen the road on the Sunday morning.

Road Resurfacing

Overnight closures from 9pm to 5am will apply on Ferry Lane from Monday 21 September to Friday 25 September. While the road closures are in place a signed diversion route will be in operation along Forest Road – Blackhorse Lane – A406 – Watermead Way. Full details can be found on the enclosed drawings

Gate control attendants will be present at each closure point to supervise the closures and assist any road users when closures are in place. Access will be available for residents during the closures but please note that residents of Bream Close (east end) will be limited to access from the east side, and residents west of Tottenham Lock will be limited to access from the west side.

Advanced warning signs will be put in place approximately 10 days before each closure. On-street notices will be put up approximately 7 days in advance of each closure. Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times.
