Subject: Objection to Tottenham Lock Building Plans

Hello,

My name is Neha and I am a resident of [REDACTED], one of the Pavillions buildings, part of the Hale village.

I would like to register my objection to the building plans at the Hale village Wharf/Tottenham Lock site.

I have seen the plans for the proposed buildings and I would like to register my objection to the big 14, 15 and 21 story towers being proposed. This will dominate the skyline, end the sense of openness, overshadow the Paddock and the reservoirs, and create a “canyon” like effect with the 12-storey pavilion blocks of Hale Village on the other side.

Since there are already plans to build 4-6 story buildings along most of the Hale village Wharf site, to which we have no objections, NB Haringey can still meet it’s 5 year Housing Zone target of 2,000 homes within 5 years, and 5,000 in total at Tottenham Hale, without building so high on this site.
