

# Statutory consultation

## Admission arrangements for Haringey community and voluntary controlled schools for 2024-25 and proposed planned admission number reductions

### Haringey is consulting on:

- Proposed admission arrangements for entry to school in the academic year 2024/25 for community and voluntary controlled schools
- Proposed co-ordinated schemes for admission of children to Year 7 and Reception in September 2024
- Proposed In-year Fair Access Protocol for the year starting 1 March 2023 which all Haringey schools and academies must follow
- Proposed reductions of 1 form of entry (30 places) at several primary schools

Demand for primary school places have consistently fallen in recent years and our future projections for demand show a further decline. The council is therefore consulting on the proposal to reduce the planned admission number (PAN) for the following primary schools:
