## **Re: Revised Consultation on Core Strategy Fundamental Changes – 3 November 2011**

We write with reference to the borough's core strategy aim of changing the designation of Markfield Road N15 from Industrial Land to Employment Land.

This target will not be achieved while the waste disposal sites at 82 Markfield Road together with the one at the rear of 100-118 remain in operation.

The road is in constant use by heavy waste disposal trucks and skip lorries from 7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday. Not only do these trucks damage the road and pose a danger to pedestrians but they also cause serious congestion as they queue to enter the yard.

The depot itself has long been a cause of concern both for industrial and residential neighbours. In the summer it sends up huge clouds of dust from the building waste processed on the site, and the run-off, via the drainage system, pollutes the River Lea.

The sites are currently occupied by O' Donovan's (Waste Disposal) Ltd, which is registered at Companies House under SIC 7487 (Other Business Activities) but since the primary business activity of this company is the collection, transport and disposal of building waste - as clearly shown by the huge mountain of rubble in the Google Earth image attached – surely it would be more accurate if it was registered under SIC 4511 (Demolition buildings; earth moving).

Furthermore, the site is also used by Kayleigh Plant Hire, registered at 483 Green Lane, Palmers Green. The company is owned by the O'Donovan family and listed as SIC 4550 (Rent construction equipment with operator).

Neither of these SICs are supported under the standard definitions of Employment Land. It therefore follows that as long as these companies are permitted to operate in Markfield Road the Core Strategy targets cannot be achieved.

Please keep us advised of the progress of the borough's core strategy together with dates of any meetings that are due to be held.
